Weather Conditions Information 19/20 SY

This memorandum is intended as information sharing for the community regarding weather conditions and students being outside. Please note the following.

- Doors open in the morning at 7:45. Do not drop your child off before that time. If for some reason your child is dropped off before that time the vestibule is open on the north-east end of the building near the office. This will provide a space for a child to be inside and away from the extreme weather conditions.
- Students will be going outside for recess as long as the “feels like” temperature is 20 degrees or above. Please make sure that your child is prepared for recess. Students should have coats, hats, and gloves with them at school. If you need help with these items please contact the school as resources to support our families are available.
- When temperatures and heat index temperatures begin to exceed 100 degrees teachers may choose to keep students inside for recess and class. Remember students are allowed to have appropriate bottles of water with them but they are expected to use these as intended.
- The Board of Education of NH-M voted to implement E-Learning days in lieu of emergency days this year. Information regarding this program will be set home, but plans for implementation will not be before December 2019.
